General criteria

- Entries that have previously been exhibited are eligible
- Entrants can submit up to three entries
- The design source should be acknowledged if not the original design of the exhibitor
- No sale or purchase of exhibits will be undertaken
- In the event of a public enquiry for purchase, consent for sharing of contact details of the exhibitor will be included on the Exhibition entry form
- Consent for photographic publication of the exhibits for promotion or advertising by the Shetland Society of Wellington will be requested on the Exhibition entry form
- All entries will be subject to a selection process and inclusion in the exhibition is at the discretion of the selection committee.
- No correspondence or communication will be entered into regarding the entry.

Exhibit criteria

Exhibits can be constructed from any natural or synthetic yarn or textile

Dimensions:

- Two-dimensional exhibits no greater than 1.5m x 1.5m
- Wall hangings/quilts must have provision for hanging
- Three-dimensional exhibits must include a level surface at the base for display or have provision for hanging and be no greater than 1mH x 500mW x 500mD

Insurance of the exhibit while in transit to or from the exhibition and during installation and display is the full responsibility of the exhibitor
