In September 2022 the Shetland Society of Wellington will be 100 years old. We want to celebrate the links between NZ and Shetland through traditional and contemporary textile and fibre art and crapt. We encourage entries to our exhibition from textile and fibre artists and craptspeople, weavers, felters, knitters, quilters and others.
